## Building Stronger Communities

Since its founding, Lincoln Financial Group has recognized that good corporate citizenship is intrinsic to its success. The company’s spirit of philanthropy led to the establishment of the Lincoln Financial Foundation in 1962 and has inspired a rich tradition of giving ever since. In 2018, the Foundation donated approximately \$9.2 million to a wide variety of philanthropic endeavors throughout the United States.

The Foundation’s approach to local philanthropic giving reflects Lincoln Financial’s strong connection to its communities. Recognizing that the employees in its affiliate offices can best determine the needs of their respective communities, the company created an employee-giving network by establishing local Charitable Contribution Committees in our primary business locations. These committees review grant proposals and award grants to the nonprofit organizations they believe will make an enduring impact on their communities.

## Employee Giving and Matching Gifts

Lincoln Financial employees in the Greater Philadelphia area, including the Philadelphia and Radnor offices, also participated in workplace giving that totaled \$127,761 to United Way agencies where the employees live.

In 2018, the Foundation matched 115 employee donations to Pennsylvania nonprofits for a total of \$268,796. The Foundation’s matching gift program leverages employee and retiree donations to community nonprofits.

In 2018, Lincoln Financial made 72 foundation grants and corporate contributions totaling \$2,042,500 in the Greater Philadelphia region in the areas of youth education, human services, economic/workforce development, and the arts.
